Master of Science in Environmental Science Degree-Seeking applicants must provide:

_Three (3) Recommendation Forms, with academic abilities assessed are required.*

(Send **electronically**, as part of your application, <u>after</u> submitting application via CNU LIVE.)

*A reference letter alone is not adequate.

<u>GRE</u> Scores from the General Test (taken within 5 years prior to the date of admission) Minimum score of 295 for Verbal and Quantitative sections combined—with reasonably balanced scores between the two sections.

Those with a combined score of 300 or above should experience success in the graduate program.

Procurement of a Thesis Advisor is required prior to admission for applicants pursuing a thesis option.

Prospective students should contact graduate faculty members from <u>Organismal & Environmental Biology or</u> <u>Molecular Biology & Chemistry</u> with similar research interests to determine one who is accepting new graduate students. Please schedule a meeting to determine their availability to serve as the Advisor/Chair of the Thesis.

Applicants are encouraged to speak with the <u>Graduate Program Coordinator</u> if assistance is needed in selecting graduate faculty members to contact and request membership on the thesis committee.

Applicants for the TRADITIONAL ENVS program have a thesis <u>or</u> non-thesis option. The curriculum for each is detailed in the *Graduate Catalog*.
