

# **Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) Emergency Federal Grant Application**

Under the CARES Act, the U.S. Department of Education has provided funding to institutions of higher education to deliver emergency financial assistance to students impacted by the disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19.

#### **Eligibility**

These funds must be awarded to students who have incurred expenses directly related to the disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19 to include eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance such as food, housing, course materials, technology, medical and child care expenses and must be issued in the form of grants to students.

Grant amounts will be determined on a case-by-case basis and may vary depending on factors such as expense type and demonstrated financial need as determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

**Section B: Explanation of Expenses Incurred** – Emergency grant funds must be awarded for expenses

directly related to the disruption of campus operations due to the COVID-19; this is different from a change in a financial need due to COVID-19, which could be a result of a loss of income rather than new expenses. Indicate expense type(s) and provide an explanation describing how each applicable expense was directly related to the disruption of campus

operations rather than a typically incurred expense.
