## **Externally Funded Summer Scholars**

This is an auxiliary program to CNU's Summer Scholars program, which will make available to select students the same discounted on-campus housing currently available to Summer Scholars through the Office of Student Research and Creative Activity (ORCA). Such students are working with faculty who have external funding and will be offered summer housing at the same reduced rate, along with a funded research internship. This program is unavailable to externally funded students living off-campus.

External funding for a **paid** experience is a requirement to participate.

No Summer Scholars funds will be used for either the student wages or the student housing. Funding comes from external grants and, on occasion, corporate funding.

Given that their faculty mentors are prepared to spend grant monies on these students, it is assumed that they have already been professionally vetted and will not have to be further reviewed. The faculty mentor will simply submit a form with the required student information, confirmation of the source of funds, and a one-page description of the proposed research.

The student will be contacted by the ORCA, which will handle only the housing arrangements with the Office of Housing; the originating department will process any student hiring paperwork for payroll.

These students will be invited to participate in all Summer Scholars activities and will be required to present at the Summer Scholars Family Weekend Symposium.
