## WARWICK RIVER HALL

Warwick River Hall opened in August 2012 and accommodates 447 residents in four-, five- and six-person suites. Residents share two community kitchens located in the Atrium area on each floor.

### Each room contains:

- Single beds with 36" x 80" mattresses
- Study desks with two-position desk chairs
- Wardrobes and dressers
- Couch or love seat, coffee table, and lounge chairs
- Small refrigerator/freezer with attached microwave
- Basic cable TV service
- Ethernet and cable outlets

### Residents share:

- Multipurpose rooms
- Study lounges
- Community kitchen
- WiFi available in the building
- Two coin-operated laundry rooms on each floor
